**HYATT REGENCY DENVER AT COLORADO CONVENTION CENTER  
CELEBRATES GRAND OPENING ON DECEMBER 20**

*To Mark the Opening Hyatt Executives and Community Officials Host Ribbon  
Cutting Ceremony, Hotel Illumination and Fireworks Display*

**DENVER (December 9, 2005)** – Denver Convention Center Hotel Authority Board President Gail Klapper joins Denver Mayor John Hickenlooper, Faulkner U.S.A. Vice President of Operations Ted Althoff and Hyatt Corporation Executive Vice President Chuck Floyd on Tuesday, December 20, 2005, at 11:30 a.m. for a ribbon cutting ceremony to officially open the highly anticipated \$285 million, 1,100-room Hyatt Regency Denver at Colorado Convention Center hotel. The hotel will be open to the public following the ceremony.

The day of celebration will continue at 5:30 p.m. when the Hyatt joins the city's skyline during a "illumination ceremony." Klapper, Mayor Hickenlooper and John Schafer, general manager of the hotel, will flip an oversized switch lighting the hotel. The illumination will culminate with a rooftop fireworks display.

"It isn't every day you get to open a beautiful, 1,100-room hotel," says Schafer. "December 20<sup>th</sup> is about celebrating this exciting day with everyone in the community."
